- Official documentation of identification from an Inuit region or community
- Nunavut Tunngavik Inc. Card
- Native American Tribal Enrollment documentation

Proof of Indigenous Ancestry is not required for the ISU Allyship Scholarship. Please note that the above list is not exhaustive and serves only as a guide for applicants. 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SECTION 2 - SCHOLARSHIP CATEGORIES *

All scholarships offered by the Indigenous Students' Union have a value of \$1000.

General Eligibility: Proof of Indigenous Ancestry must be provided to assess the eligibility for all scholarship categories, **EXCEPT** the Allyship Award. Each scholarship category has additional eligibility requirements.

☐ Indigenous Student Volunteerism Award

The Indigenous Student Volunteerism Award recognizes Indigenous students who have demonstrated a strong commitment to community service by making meaningful contributions through volunteerism on campus and/or in the broader community during their post-secondary studies.

Eligibility: Must be enrolled as an undergraduate student at the University of Alberta.

☐ Indigenous Student Award for Outstanding Academic Achievement

The Indigenous Student Award for Outstanding Academic Achievement recognizes Indigenous students who demonstrate academic excellence. It is awarded to the applicant with the highest academic standing from the preceding Winter Term, based on GPA and the number of credits completed. Where a distinction cannot be made on the basis of academic achievement alone, extracurricular involvement may also be considered.

Eligibility:

- Enrolled as an undergraduate student at the University of Alberta.
- Minimum grade point average of 2.5 in the preceding Fall and Winter terms.

☐ Indigenous Student Athletics Award

The Indigenous Student Athletics Award recognizes Indigenous students at the University of Alberta whose achievements in athletics and recreational activities reflect dedication, leadership, sportsmanship, and a commitment to wellness. Preference will be given to Golden Bears or Pandas student-athletes.

Eliaibility:

- Enrolled as an undergraduate student at the University of Alberta.
- Must demonstrate satisfactory academic standing.

☐ Indigenous Students' Union Allyship Award

The Indigenous Students' Union Allyship Award recognizes non-Indigenous students who are actively engaged in the ISU community and who demonstrate meaningful allyship through a strong commitment to decolonization, education, and challenging oppressive systems.

Eligibility:

- Enrolled as an undergraduate student at the University of Alberta.
- Must identify as non-Indigenous.
- Must be nominated by an Indigenous Member of the Indigenous Students' Union
